Analyse the predictive accuracy of studies or theories from comparative psychology when applied to the individual behaviour of non-human animals. [20 marks] 3. Many non-human animals interact in groups for much of their lives. Assess the impact of such behaviour on their survival. [20 marks] **Cultural Psychology** 4. Discuss how human behaviour may be affected by cultural dimensions. [20 marks] 5. Discuss problems faced by psychologists conducting cross-cultural research. [20 marks] With reference to two research studies, explain how human development continues 15. throughout the lifespan. [20 marks] **Psychodynamic Psychology 16.** Describe **one** research study from psychodynamic psychology. [8 marks] Explain how methodological considerations may affect the interpretation of findings (b) of the study described in part (a). [12 marks] 17. [20 marks] Describe and evaluate **one** neo-Freudian theory.

**18.** Compare and contrast **two** psychodynamic explanations of human behaviour (*e.g.* aggression, gender differences). [20 marks]

- **20.** Assess the extent to which findings of **one** study of obedience **or** conformity allow predictions to be made about individual or group behaviour. [20 marks]
