- (b) Explain one strength **or** one limitation of the method used in the study outlined in part (a). [4 marks]

#### Cognitive Perspective

2. Explain **one** methodological consideration related to a research study from the cognitive perspective. [8 marks]

#### Learning Perspective

3. Explain how **one** key concept from the learning perspective relates to determinism. [8 marks]

### SECTION B

Answer **one** question in this section. Marks will be awarded for clear presentation of **theories**, inclusion of appropriate **empirical studies** and **evaluation**.

4. Discuss strengths **and** limitations of **one** explanation of behaviour from the biological perspective. [20 marks]
  5. Explain how cultural considerations may affect interpretation of behaviour from the cognitive perspective. [20 marks]
  6. To what extent is the learning perspective effective in explaining **one** psychological **or** social question? [20 marks]
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
